Dear Mr. Blount:

From June 20 to 22, 2017, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration, Office of Pipeline Safety pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Colonial Pipeline Company's (Colonial) procedures in Woodbine, Maryland. As a result of the inspection, Colonial was issued a Notice of Amendment (NOA) on April 17, 2018, which proposed amendment of its procedures.

Colonial submitted its amended procedures on May 18, 2018. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this NOA have been corrected.
