Dear Mr. McIlwain:

From April 3 to August 11, 2017, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration, Office of Pipeline Safety pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Sunoco Pipeline, L.P. (Sunoco) Mariner East 1 pipeline for operations, maintenance and emergencies in Washington County, PA. As a result of the inspection, Sunoco was issued a Notice of Amendment (NOA) on August 22, 2018, which proposed amendment of its procedures.

On September 21, 2018, Sunoco submitted Energy Transfer's Standard Operating Procedure HLM.01, which replaced Sunoco's previous procedure. My staff reviewed these procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this NOA have been corrected as a result.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
