Mr. Burrough,

The Notice of Amendment (NOA) referenced above and dated August 22, 2018 was received by Sunoco Pipeline L.P. (SPLP) on August 23, 2018 via electronic mail. SPLP is a wholly owned subsidiary of Energy Transfer Partners (ETP). This NOA provided SPLP 30 days to respond.

SPLP submits with this cover letter a copy of the Energy Transfer Standard Operating Procedure HLM.01. As of May 1, 2018 the Energy Transfer Standard Operating Procedures fully replaced the SPLP DOT Maintenance Manual. This change was communicated to PHMSA on June 25, 2018 via Operator Registry Notification no. C-20180625-20740.

Specifically, HLM.01 replaced SPLP DOT Maintenance Manual Procedure 195.420 which is the subject of this NOA.


Energy Transfer Standard Operating Procedure HLM.01 identifies:

1. The valves necessary for the safe operation of the pipeline system which includes mainline valves
2. The required inspection frequency
3. Instructions for inspection, maintenance and operation of such valves

SPLP believes that HLM.01 adequately addresses the findings identified in the subject NOA.
