From February 19 - 22, 2019, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.) inspected Kinder Morgan's (KM) Underground Gas Storage Facility (UNGS) Program in Houston, TX for the Kinder Morgan Tejas Pipeline (KM). As a result of the inspection, KM was issued a Notice of Amendment on November 26, 2019, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

KM submitted its amended procedures on or about January 27, 2020. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
