Dear Director Burrough:

On May 20, 2019, Sunoco Pipeline, L.P. (SPLP or the Company) received the above referenced Notice of Probable Violation (NOPV) and Proposed Compliance Order (PCO) that were issued by the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA). SPLP takes its commitment to pipeline safety and compliance seriously, and in light of that commitment, the Company believes there are some inaccuracies in the NOPV that should be corrected.

SPLP has met with the PHMSA Eastern Region to discuss the issues raised in the NOPV and the PCO, and the Company appreciates the Region's willingness to address some of these issues already. SPLP believes this matter is capable of resolution without resort to a hearing, particularly given that a majority of the items requested in the PCO have already been addressed by SPLP. In order to allow for discussions with PHMSA to continue, the Company respectfully requests a settlement meeting with the Eastern Region. In order to preserve its rights, however, SPLP is timely filing the attached Request for Hearing.
