Dear Mr. Amundsen:

From September 10 - 12, 2019, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.), conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Energy Transfer Company's (ETC) procedures for operations and maintenance in Houston, Texas. As a result of the inspection, ETC was issued a Notice of Amendment on November 26, 2019, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

On December 27, 2019, ETC requested an extension of time until February 19, 2020 to respond. On January 2, 2020, PHMSA granted the time extension. ETC submitted its amended procedures on February 19, 2020. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
