On February 4-6, 2020, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation's (Niagara) procedures at its LNG plant in Providence, Rhode Island. As a result of the inspection, Niagara was issued a Notice of Amendment on May 12, 2020, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Niagara submitted its amended procedures on June 9, 2020. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
