From September 16-19, 2019, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.) inspected Columbia Gas Transmission, LLC's (Columbia) procedures for Underground Natural Gas Storage in Charleston, West Virginia. As a result of the inspection, Columbia was issued a Notice of Amendment on January 2, 2020, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Columbia submitted its amended procedures in parts, on or around January 31st, May 5th and June 3rd of 2020. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
