From July 22, 2019, to October 10, 2019, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) and an inspector from the New York Department of Public Service (NY DPS), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.) inspected Kiantone Pipeline Corporation's (Kiantone) procedures for facilities in Warren, Pennsylvania and West Seneca Terminal, Tonawanda, New York. As a result of the inspection, Kiantone was issued a Notice of Amendment on April 30, 2020, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Kiantone submitted its amended procedures on May 27th of 2020. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
