Dear Mr. D' Alessandro:

From November 9, 2020 to November 18, 2020, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.) inspected UGI Energy Services' (UGI) procedures for the Temple LNG Plant in Reading, Pennsylvania. As a result of the inspection, UGI was issued a Notice of Amendment (NOA) on April 19, 2021, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

On August 6, 2021 UGI submitted its amended procedures for items 2 – 9, only. On March 11, 2022, PHMSA issued an Ordering Directing Amendment (Order) to UGI requiring UGI to amend certain portions of its procedures. On April 18, 2022 UGI provided its response to the Order. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Order have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
