From October 29, 2020 to June 10, 2021, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected Collins Pipeline Co's (Collins Pipeline) procedures, records and made observations during an Integrated Inspection in Collins, MS, Chalmette, LA, and via virtual meetings. As a result of the inspection, Collins Pipeline was issued a Notice of Amendment on February 8, 2022, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
