Dear Ms. Quinones:

From November 17, 2020, through November 21, 2020, an inspector from the California Geologic Energy Management Division (CalGEM), acting as an agent for the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.) inspected Pacific Gas & Electric Company's (PGE) procedures for McDonald Island, Pleasant Creek, and Los Medanos underground natural gas storage (UNGS) facilities located in San Joaquin, Yolo, and Contra Costa counties, California, respectively. As a result of the inspection, PGE was issued a Notice of Amendment on January 28, 2022, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

PGE submitted its amended procedures on February 25, 2022 and May 13, 2022. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
