RE: Warning Letter (CPF-1-2022-008-WL)

Mr. Burrough,

This letter is in response to your Warning Letter dated January 28, 2022, and received by MIPC, LLC (MIPC).

During a series of investigations by representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) in 2021, PHMSA identified a probable violation within MIPC's plans and procedures, as described below. Though PHMSA did not require MIPC's response to the probable violation, we wanted to address PHMSA's finding and ensure that proper corrective measures have occurred.

1. § 195.420 Valve maintenance.

(a) ...

(b) Each operator shall, at intervals not exceeding 7 1/2 months, but at least twice each calendar year, inspect each mainline valve to determine that it is functioning properly.

MIPC is committed to operating our terminal and pipeline system safely and in compliance with all applicable regulations. To that end, MIPC has updated and revised our *Idle and Abandon Pipeline Procedures* as well as our *Main Line Valve Inspections Procedures* to either meet or exceed the criteria set forth in API RP 1181
