From May 3 through May 7, 2021, representatives from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted a Control Room safety inspection of Menzies Aviation's procedures for its Jet Fuel Crosstown Pipeline located in Anchorage, Alaska. As a result of the inspection, Menzies Aviation was issued a Notice of Amendment on April 26, 2022, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Menzies Aviation's submitted its amended procedures on May 24, 2022. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
