On February 28, 2013, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS) issued to The Pipelines of Puerto Rico, Inc. (PLPR) a Final Order in the above-referenced case, which included an assessed civil penalty and a Compliance Order.

The OPS Southern Region received and reviewed PLPR's email response to the compliance items in the Order.
