On October 1, 2014, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS) issued Florida Public Utilities Company (FPU) a Final Order with an attached Compliance Order (CO) in the above-referenced case. The CO required FPU to undertake certain actions to ensure compliance with the federal pipeline safety regulations.

The OPS Southern Region received and reviewed FPU's response to the CO dated January 20, 2015. Based on our review of the actions taken by FPU, we have determined that FPU has complied with the terms of the CO and the Final Order.

This case is now closed and no further action is necessary with respect to the matters involved in this case.
