Dear Mr. Keyser:

On July 28-29, 2015, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS), Southern Region inspected the Texas Gas Transmission, LLC (TGT) Operator Qualification program at your office in Owensboro, Kentucky, pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code. TGT is a subsidiary of Boardwalk Pipeline Partners, LP (BWP). As a result of the inspection, PHMSA issued a Notice of Amendment (NOA) on October 13, 2015.

The OPS Southern Region has received and reviewed several written responses to the NOA from TGT, including TGT's final response dated July 21, 2016. Based on our review of these responses we have determined that TGT has complied with the terms of the NOA. This case is now closed and no further action is necessary with respect to the matters involved in this case.

Please be advised that this letter refers only to the referenced NOA (**CPF 2-2015-1006M**) and not to any other PHMSA cases, if any.
