AmeriGas Propane, LP, received the Notice of Probable Violation and Compliance Order dated September 5, 2018 which indicated four propane system inspections where alleged violations of Title 49 CFR Part 192 were found. AmeriGas now submits our remedial actions for the two cited systems serviced by the St. Augustine and Holly Hill Districts.

AmeriGas is committed to the safety of our employees, customers, and neighbors and compliance with Federal regulations. AmeriGas takes PHMSA's concerns seriously. While AmeriGas does not agree that the circumstances identified by PHMSA constitute actual violations, in the interest of cooperation with PHMSA, AmeriGas corrected the alleged violations soon after we were notified of the concerns. Here, we are providing documentation showing the steps we took to correct the alleged violations as described below.

The responses are organized to address each violation description by location. These responses are not an admission by AmeriGas that the violations alleged by PHMSA are actual violations.
