On August 8, 2019, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) issued to Genesis Pipeline USA, LP (Genesis) a Final Order in the above-referenced case. The Final Order included a Compliance Order (CO) which required Genesis to undertake certain actions to ensure compliance with the federal pipeline safety regulations.

In response to the CO, Genesis made numerous submittals to OPS Southern Region, documenting its efforts toward compliance.

Based upon our review of documentation of actions taken, we have determined that Genesis has complied with the terms of the CO and the Final Order. This case is now closed and no further action is necessary with respect to the matters involved in this case.
