On April 4-8, April 11-15, April 25-29, and May 9-13, 2005, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected Jayhawk Pipeline's operation and maintenance procedures at field facility locations in Kansas. As a result of the inspection, Jayhawk Pipeline was issued a Notice of Amendment on February 26, 2007, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
