On September 22, 2009, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) issued to Magellan Pipeline Company, L.L.C. (Magellan) a Consent Order (Order) in the above-referenced case. In summary, the Order included a Consent Agreement containing a civil penalty and compliance measures to establish emergency procedures, train personnel, and make modifications at the Kansas City Terminal. Based on a review of the documentation Magellan provided, on-site inspection by PHMSA Central Region, and confirmation of payment of the civil penalty, it has been determined that you have complied with the terms of the Order and associated Consent Agreement.
