We are in receipt of your letter dated November 23, 2010, regarding the above referenced inspection lead by PHMSA's Central Region.

Item 1 § 195.403 Emergency Response Training

Item 2 § 195.412 Inspection of rights-of-way and crossings under navigable waters.

Item 3 § 195.452 Pipeline integrity management in high consequence areas.

These three items are identified as Warning Items and do not require written response. Mid-Valley Pipeline Co. does not choose to contest these issues as noted in your letter.

Item 4 § 195.573 What must I do to monitor external corrosion control?

(e) Corrective action. You must correct any identified deficiency in corrosion control as required by Sec. 195.401(b).


§ 195.401 General requirements.

(b) Whenever an operator discovers any condition that could adversely affect the safe operation of its pipeline system, it shall correct it within a reasonable time. However if the condition is of such a nature that it presents an immediate hazard to persons or property, the operator may not operate the affected part of the system until it has corrected the unsafe condition.

This item was noted in your letter as having been corrected in July 2009, but was determined not to have been remediated in a reasonable time frame. Additionally, a \$48,700.00 proposed civil penalty was assessed. Mid-Valley Pipeline Co. does not choose to contest this item and will submit payment as prescribed in your letter.
