Dear Mr. Justin:

During the weeks of June 22-26, July 20-24, and July 27-31, 2009, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected Mid-Valley Pipeline Company's (Mid-Valley's) procedures for operations, maintenance, integrity management, and operator qualification in Houston, Texas, and Sinking Spring, Pennsylvania. As a result of the inspection, Mid-Valley was issued a Notice of Amendment on November 23, 2010, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

On April 30, 2011, Mid-Valley submitted its proposed revisions. Additional procedure revisions were subsequently submitted on February 20, 2012, and May 29, 2012. My staff reviewed the amended procedures and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in the Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and that this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
