Dear Mr. Maki:

On August 15-18, October 24-27, 2011 and January 16-18, 2012, representatives of the Michigan Public Service Commission (MI-PSC) acting as an interstate agent for the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected your facilities and the operation and maintenance procedures for Vector Pipeline L.P. (Vector) at your offices in Griffith, IN. As a result of the inspection, Vector Pipeline L.P. was issued a Notice of Amendment on March 21, 2012, which proposed amendment of the procedures.

Vector Pipeline LP submitted its amended procedures on June 22, 2012, and again on October 23, 2012 and November 1, 2012. The MI-PSC along with my staff reviewed the amended procedures and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
