Dear Mr. Barrett:

The purpose of this letter is to acknowledge receipt of the Notice of Probable Violation and Proposed Compliance Order (CPF 3-2013-0003). The order lists eleven line items, (4) Warning items and (7) items included in a Proposed Compliance Order. The order was issued as a consequence of an inspection conducted on 09/17/2012 in Lacrosse, WI, at the former Tru-Gas, Inc., now owned by Suburban Propane, L.P..

In regards to the Warning items, please be advised that corrections have been made for items (3) and (9), and are in-process for (1) and (2) pending required evaluation and approval by the property owner at Pineview Trailer Park.

Suburban Propane does not contest the Proposed Compliance Order but we are requesting additional time to submit written explanations and documentation in response to demonstrate compliance. It is stated in item 8. of the Proposed Compliance Order that all documentation must be submitted for review within (60) days "after the Final Order has been issued." We expect to have the information submitted on or before 09/15/2013. Please advise if this time-frame is acceptable for submission to your office.

In conclusion, we assert that our position is to fully cooperate with PHMSA.
