From August 2, 2010, to January 18, 2011, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of BP Pipelines (North America), Inc. procedures. As a result of the inspection, BP Pipelines (North America), Inc. was issued a Notice of Amendment on February 15, 2013, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
