Pursuant to 49 CFR Part 190.209(a)(1) and I.a.1 of the "Response Options for Pipeline Operators in Compliance Proceedings," National Cooperative Refinery Association (NCRA), on behalf of NCRA, Jayhawk Pipeline, L.L.C. and Kaw Pipe Line Company, is notifying PHMSA that we are not contesting the Proposed Civil Penalty as stated in the subject letter dated April 5, 2013 received on April 8, 2013. The penalty of \$82,400 will be wire transferred on May 6, 2013.

In addition, NCRA on behalf of NCRA, Jayhawk Pipeline, L.L.C. and Kaw Pipe Line Company is notifying PHMSA that we are not contesting the Proposed Compliance Order. Once we receive the final Compliance Order, we will respond to the final Compliance Order in the manner and time frame specified in the Proposed Compliance Order.
