On November 7 – 9, 2011, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of NuStar Pipeline Operating Partnership, LP's procedures in San Antonio, Texas. As a result of the inspection, NuStar Pipeline Operating Partnership, LP was issued a Notice of Amendment on July 24, 2013, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
