Following an incident that occurred at Plains Pipeline, LP's (Plains) Pocahontas Station in Bond County, Illinois on July 10, 2015, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) issued a Corrective Action Order (CAO) in the above-referenced case to Plains on July 14, 2015. The CAO ordered Plains to take certain corrective measures. On July 16, 2015, PHMSA issued an Amended CAO, updating one of the preliminary findings.

Based on our review of the documentation you provided in reference to this matter, it has been determined that you have complied with the terms of the CAO.
