Between July 20, 2015 and December 4, 2015, representatives of the Michigan Public Service Commission (MI-PSC) acting as an interstate agent for the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected ANR Pipeline Company's (ANR) procedures for integrity management in Troy, Michigan. As a result of the inspection, ANR was issued a Notice of Amendment on March 16, 2017, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

ANR provided its amended procedures on June 12, 2017 and a revision on December 18, 2017. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
