On September 15, 2017, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) issued to TransCanada Corporation a Final Order (Order) in the above referenced case. This Order included a Compliance Order and Civil Penalty assessment. On November 14, 2017, PHMSA received the documentation required by Item 2 of the Compliance Order, summarizing the operator qualification records and the completion of the atmospheric corrosion surveys of your facilities.
