On January 8 - 12, January 29- February 2, February 12 - 16 and April 16 - 20, 2018, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Oasis Petroleum North America's (Oasis) procedures in Houston, TX.
