On August 7-9, 2018, representatives from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Ferrellgas procedures for Operations & Maintenance, Damage Prevention, Public Awareness, Operator Qualifications, Integrity Management and Emergency Response in Green Bay, Wisconsin. As a result of the inspection, Ferrellgas was issued a Notice of Amendment (Notice) on April 29, 2019, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Ferrellgas responded to the Notice on November 12, 2019, with your amended procedures. My staff reviewed the amended procedures and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
