Dear Mr. Werth:

On March 8, 2017, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected your Safety Related Condition Report (PHMSA Reference 20170019) pertaining to facilities near Alexander, North Dakota. As a result of the inspection, the Director, Central Region, OPS issued a Notice of Probable Violation, Proposed Civil Penalty and Proposed Compliance Order (Notice) on April 29, 2019. On December 2, 2019, PHMSA issued a Final Order, which made findings of violation, assessed a civil penalty, and ordered Caliber Midstream to take certain compliance measures.

The records show that Caliber Midstream paid the civil penalty, in addition to submitting testing procedures, completing the testing and documentation. My staff has reviewed these documents and determined that the terms of the Compliance Order have been met. This case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
