Targa Resources Operating LLC (Targa) is submitting this revised response to the Notice of Probable Violation, Proposed Civil Penalty, and Proposed Compliance Order (“NOPV”) originally sent October 25, 2019. After phone discussion with PHMSA Operations Supervisor Greg Ochs, Targa plans to add valves outside the containment dike at Tank 200 & 210 at the Johnson’s Corner Facility and Tank 3000 at the New Town Facility. Valves are scheduled to be installed by March 31, 2020.

Additionally, at Tank 210 at Johnson’s Corner Facility, the slope will be addressed when enough snow has melted (most likely April).

Targa understands the importance of mitigating the issues identified above and will communicate to PHMSA when all actions mentioned above are complete.
