On June 26-28, July 24-26, and July 31-August 2, 2018, representatives from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Targa Resources Operating, LLC's (Targa) procedures for Operations & Maintenance, Damage Prevention, Public Awareness, Operator Qualifications, Integrity Management and Emergency Response in Watford City, ND. As a result of the inspection, Targa was issued a Notice of Amendment on September 26, 2019, which proposed and acknowledged the amendment of your procedures.

My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment were corrected prior to the Notice.
