On March 19-23, 2018, and September 10-14, 2018, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Crestwood Equity Partners LP (Crestwood) procedures in Williston, North Dakota. As a result of the inspection, Crestwood Crestwood was issued a Notice of Amendment on November 22, 2019, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Crestwood submitted its amended procedures in November 2019 and January 2020 with final versions submitted on April 15, 2020. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
