On March 25 – 29 and September 9 - 13, 2019, representatives from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of Phillips 66 Pipeline LLC's (Phillips 66) procedures in Houston, Texas and Keene, North Dakota. As a result of the inspection, Phillips 66 was issued a Notice of Amendment on November 5, 2020, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Phillips 66 submitted its amended procedures on February 5, 2021. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
