On April 29 to June 27, 2019, representatives from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected Citgo Petroleum Corporation's (Citgo) procedures in Houston, TX and Citgo's East Chicago Terminal in East Chicago, Indiana. As a result of the inspection, Citgo was issued a Notice of Amendment on November 5, 2020, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
