From August 10 through 14, 2020, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted a remote pipeline safety inspection of Suncor Energy (USA) Pipeline Co. (Suncor) procedures in Sherwood Park, Alberta, Canada. As a result of the inspection, Suncor was issued a Notice of Amendment on May 6, 2021, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Suncor submitted its amended procedures on September 3, 2021. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
