From March 15 through April 9, 2021, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected your Operation and Maintenance (O&M) procedures for Jayhawk Pipeline LLC (Jayhawk). As a result of the inspection, Jayhawk was issued a Notice of Amendment on October 1, 2021, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
