From April 30, 2018, through August 17, 2018, a representative of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected Jayhawk Pipeline, LLC's (Jayhawk) written operations and maintenance (O&M) procedures in McPherson, Kansas. As a result of the inspection, Jayhawk was issued a Notice of Amendment on February 9, 2021, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

Jayhawk submitted its amended procedures on March 10, 2021. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.
