From February 24, 2020, through December 9, 2021, representatives from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code (U.S.C.), inspected NuStar Logistics, L.P.'s (NuStar)¹ procedures for its pipeline facilities in Texas, Oklahoma, New Mexico, and Colorado subject to 49 CFR Part 195. As a result of the inspection, NuStar was issued a Notice of Amendment on January 28, 2022, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

NuStar submitted its amended procedures on or before December 26, 2021. My staff reviewed the amended procedures, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
