From June 29, 2021 to July 1, 2021, a representative from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an on-site pipeline safety inspection of WTG-Hugoton, LP's (WTG) procedures for system operation and maintenance in Hugoton, Kansas. As a result of the inspection, WTG was issued a Notice of Amendment on January 24, 2022, which proposed amendment of WTG's procedures.

On September 13, 2021, WTG submitted its amended procedure P-192.605(b)(6). My staff has reviewed the amended procedure and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in the Notice of Amendment have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
