
On April 3, 2007, CenterPoint Energy Gas Transmission Company ("CEGT") received a Notice of Amendment ("NOA") dated March 29, 2007, issued by the Southwest Region of the Department of Transportation's Office of Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration ("PHMSA"). In the NOA, PHMSA states that, based on PHMSA's review of CEGT's Integrity Management Program ("IMP") conducted in Shreveport, Louisiana, during the weeks of September 12-16 and November 14-18, 2005, PHMSA has identified apparent inadequacies within CEGT's IMP plans or procedures.

On April 30, 2007, CEGT submitted a letter to the Regional Director requesting additional time to submit amended procedures to comply with the NOA. In a letter dated May 30, 2007, the Regional Director issued a letter granting CEGT's request and providing CEGT until June 29, 2007 to submit amended procedures to comply with the NOA.

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CEGT hereby submits amended procedures to comply with the NOA. Please contact me if you have any questions about this submission.
