Magellan Pipeline Company, L.P. (“Magellan”) acknowledges receipt of the above referenced Notice of Amendment (NOA) and is timely sending this response within 30 days from its receipt as provided by the provisions of 49 CFR §§ 190.209(a) and (b).

Request for Extension

As directed by the “Response Options for Pipeline Operators in Compliance Proceedings, section IV “Extensions of Time”, page 3 of 5; Magellan respectfully requests an extension of time to further respond to the above referenced NOA.

The following items were specifically discussed by telephone conference on April 26, 2012, with Mr. Jon Manning. It was agreed that an extension of time would best serve resolution to outstanding issues.

Item #25 Electrical Isolation

Magellan requests time to receive and review Mr. Manning’s additional guidance material further clarifying expectations regarding Item #25. This includes methods to determine electrolytically shorted casings and 192 Natural Gas regulations / guidance on clearing shorted casings.

Item #26 Immediate Notice of Certain Accidents

Mr. Manning has requested further documentation explaining the process Magellan used for determining an initial release volume as well as detailed explanations of particular scenarios that might pose difficulties in providing a timely and accurate initial release volume.

Magellan will submit a formal response to the NOA within 30 days of the date of Magellan's request for extension. Magellan trusts this submittal meets the requirements of the subject Notice of Amendment. If you have any questions or comments, please contact me at 918-574-7326.
