Dear Mr. Brewer:

From January 30 through October 19, 2012, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected the Enable Gas Transmission, LLC/Enable Mississippi River Transmission, LLC (Enable) procedures/records for Operations and Maintenance, Integrity Management, Emergency Response, Operator Qualification, and Construction Specifications in Shreveport, LA. As a result of the inspection, Enable was issued a Notice of Probable Violation, Probable Civil Penalty, and Probable Compliance Order on June 17, 2013.

On May 29, 2015 Enable submitted a response to the Final Order. Enable provided the requested documentation and completed the Compliance Order Items on December 7, 2015. The penalty payment was made on September 26, 2014. My staff reviewed the submitted documentation, and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in the Notice of Probable Violation have been corrected.

This letter is to inform you no further action is necessary and this case is now closed. Thank you for your cooperation.
