



This letter is in response to your letter dated October 31, 2013 concerning the above reference subject. Chaparral Energy is requesting a one month extension to respond fully to your letter concerning the Proposed Civil Penalty and Proposed Compliance Order under CPF 4-2013-5025. Chaparral Energy is not contesting any of the items listed in your letter and is working to comply with all items.

Chaparral Energy is requesting this extension due to the upcoming Thanksgiving Holiday and vacation schedules of employees within Chaparral Energy and our engineering consultant.
