On October 8, 2015, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) issued to CCPS Transportation, LLC, the primary operator of the pipeline and a subsidiary of Enbridge Energy Company, a Final Order in the above-referenced case. This Order included a Compliance Order. Documents were provided to PHMSA on December 1, 2015 and September 10, 2018 to show compliance with the terms of the Compliance Order. PHMSA emphasizes the importance of the operator complying with all procedures, as well as relying on fully developed technical justifications when waiving pipe specifications. Although PHMSA does not believe that all of the justifications that the operator provided are technical in nature, given the circumstances of this particular case, this case is now closed and no further action is contemplated with respect to the matters involved in this case.
