From April 12, 2013 – April 3, 2014, representatives of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code inspected the Magellan Pipeline Company, LP (Magellan) procedures and records for their Control Room Management Program, Operations and Maintenance Plan, and Integrity Management Plan. As a result of the inspection, Magellan was issued a Notice of Amendment on December 16, 2014, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
